Indigenous First Peoples Day

Today, Monday June 21st we celebrate Indigenous First Peoples Day by students playing Indigenous Games, watching a video (CBC kids) on the origins of Indigenous groups in Canada (Inuit, Metis, First Nations). Each student made a Commitment Stick. The Commitment Sticks were a gift to students from our school Indigenous leaders. They have been smudged by Secwépemc Knowledge Keeper, Peter Michel. He burned melámen (medicine), dried sage, and swept the smoke with an eagle feather over the sticks while saying a prayer in the traditional tongue. Student painted the sticks orange and individualized them by decorating them with designs, beads and feathers.

Pride Week (organized by Student Leadership)

This week are showing our support for Pride week by wearing a different identified colour each day of the week. Each day leadership students will announce a little bit of information about the upcoming day and remind you of the colour we are hoping that you will wear. Monday will be orange, Tuesday will be pink, white and blue, Wednesday will be brown and black, Thursday will be red and Friday will be yellow.
